

JEHS – CBSE ANNUAL REPORT, 2022-23

Presented at the Annual Day Celebration held on 4th Feb 2023.

Distinguished guests, board members, parents, well-wishers, members of staff and students.

A warm and cordial welcome to each one of you on the occasion of our Annual Day Celebration, Rhapsody 22-23. It is my privilege to present before you a brief report of the activities undertaken by the school during this academic year.

We inaugurated the II floor construction of 16 class rooms on the 28th May 2022. The inauguration was done by Shri. B A Basavaraja, Minister-Urban Development.

Classes for the new academic year commenced on the 1st of June 2022. Students and staff returned to school rejuvenated after the summer vacation.

The school welcomed the new batch of kindergarten students with open arms and made a promise to hand hold them at every step of their adapting and learning process.

While the previous academic years witnessed uncertainties due to Covid-19 pandemic, it equally put tremendous pressure on teachers and students to adapt themselves to blended teaching and learning. We were forced to adapt digital tools at a scale and depth that they hadn't before. But it has not been without silver linings, the most remarkable achievement being the creativity of teachers. They found new ways to share and connect with students. Leaping forward for a change, teachers realigned their thoughts and actions, handholding the students with different teaching strategies & gradually the students discovered themselves in more meaningful ways.

The responsibility displayed by parents during this period was commendable. Through the cooperation, support and encouragement of our management and parent community we switched over to 'on-campus' teaching-learning this year with adherence to protocols and safety measures.

Investiture Ceremony was officiated in July. Donning the mantle of responsibility, the school cabinet pledged to dispense their duties to the best of their abilities. A traffic awareness safety program was organized in our school in July conducted by Honda Motorcycles & Scooters India Private Ltd in collaboration with Traffic Training and Safety Institute of Traffic Police, Hegde Nagar for students of Grades III to X. Presentation on accidents and its causes, age restrictions on riding/driving and their penal consequences, road signs, rules for zebra crossing were some of the highlights of the program. It was a very informative session and students had great takeaways.

We have initiated Malayalam classes in August, held thrice a week and around 60 students are attending the classes.

JEHS hosted Junior Premier League – Season 4, an extravagant Football and Basketball tournament in August with the participation of 26 Football teams and 16 Basketball teams representing schools all over Bangalore. This colossal venture was unanimously aimed to provide a platform to the budding sportsmen to showcase their talents. This stupendous tournament witnessed commendable performances from all the players. Delhi Public School (North) emerged as winners in the basketball tournament. Inventure Academy emerged as winners in the football tournament and aptly bagged the prestigious President's Rolling Trophy of JPL – Season 4.

Independence Day was celebrated with great patriotic fervour. Students of Jubilee Institutions presented an exemplary cultural show with patriotic songs, dazzling dance performances, march past by different platoons, taekwondo display and mass drill.

The management organized a get together in September with the staff of Jubilee Institutions and honoured them as part of Teachers' Day celebration.

Busy Bees, an Inter school competition for students of kindergarten was organized on the 19th of November. The competition was for students of age group 3 years to 6 years. We had a bellyful of events for the little ones and witnessed the buzzing busy bees overflowing our campus.

Students from secondary section participated in the inter school group dance competition conducted by deccan herald and bagged second place.

Aadya Chandra of Grade VII participated in the Extempore competition organized by Deccan herald and secured 1 place.

We have many more gems like Shawn Sheehan Christy of Grade VII, an excellent football player, Parthav Iyer of Grade V – a very good musical performer, Mohammed Reyan of Grade V – excellent in taekwondo, Rajeeva of Grade II an excellent swimmer, athanya and Riya of grade IV – marvelous performers in adimurai, a martial art, of UKG to mention a few.

We have excellent results by our Grade X students. The first batch of students secured centum results in the year 2019-20 followed by 92% in the year 2020-21 and 95% in the year 2021-22. We are extremely proud of your dear students. We wish you success in all the years to come.
